

Course on the Practice of Priestly Formation 2017-2018

In light of the new Ratio fundamentalis "The Gift of the Priestly Vocation", this course is intended for all Priests interested in:

- + **Discerning:** their own path as formators of the People of God, and with the purpose of preparing for ministry in the fields of Priestly Vocations and of the initial and ongoing formation of the Clergy.
- + **Deepening:** their own chosen vocation, the fundamental motivations and the specific aspects of their own priestly and ministerial life.
- + **Growing:** through a careful review of life in light of the gift received, to welcome of the prompting of the Holy Spirit to develop our own life of discipleship leading towards configuration to Christ the Good Shepherd.
- A valuable opportunity to *stop*, *reflect*, *examine* and *assimilate* the new *Ratio*.
- A time for *personal priestly formation* and for *formation for vocational service in the Church.*
- A joyful experience of *fraternity and sharing* with priests from all over the world.

REGISTRATION

Priests are invited to register as early as possible, and **no later than 12** October.

Those Priests who intend to register must do so personally at the Congregation for the Clergy, providing:

- A letter from his own Ordinary or the Rector of his Pontifical College, addressed to His Eminence Beniamino Cardinal STELLA, Prefect of the Congregation for the Clergy.
- Documentation regarding studies already completed or a certificate of matriculation in courses in a Pontifical or other university at licentiate level or above.
- One passport photo.
